COST: \$30 covers camp fees and Troop food for 2 meals on Saturday, 2 meals on Sunday & gasoline.

TRANSPORTATION for Troop 125:

DEPARTURE MEETING PLACE & TIME: Meet at Glenoaks Park at 6:00 A.M., for a planned exit before 6:30 A.M. Scouts should eat breakfast before arriving.

RETURN TIME: Scouts will return to Glenoaks Park by 4:00 P.M. on Sunday afternoon.

WHAT TO WEAR: Scout troop t-shirt while traveling to and from Joshua Tree. Temperature changes of 40 degrees within 24 hours are common. Bring a variety of clothes that you can layer on and off as conditions change. Highs are usually in the 70's with lows in the 40's.

WHAT TO TAKE - PERSONAL: the Scout Outdoor Essentials (and don't forget sun screen), cooking and eating utensils, warm-weather clothes and cold-weather clothes. (page 207, pages 224 thru 227). Separate detailed list to follow.

WHAT TO TAKE - PATROL: Tents, patrol flag. Check out from Troop Quartermaster: patrol box and propane tank. Patrol box includes cooking & cleaning equipment, a camp stove, propane connectors & lantern. Food (see next item)

FOOD: Troop will prepare lunch and dinner on Saturday, breakfast and lunch on Sunday.

ACTIVITIES: 8 mile hike on the Boy Scout Trail and a rock scramble.
