**RETURN TIME:** Leave campground after breakfast for return to Glenoaks Park by noon (or slightly sooner), March 21<sup>st</sup>, 2010



**WHAT TO WEAR:** Scouts should wear their activity shirts.

**WHAT TO TAKE - PERSONAL:** the Scout Outdoor Essentials (and don't forget sun screen!), cooking and eating utensils, warm-weather clothes for the night (long pants, jacket, hat etc.), sleeping bag, flashlights, compass, good shoes, Scout Handbook.

**WHAT TO TAKE - PATROL:** Tents. Cooking & cleaning equipment, a camp stove, propane connectors & lantern. Food (see next item)

**FOOD:** Saturday lunch and dinner and Sunday breakfast. (come to park on Saturday with breakfast already eaten)

**ACTIVITIES:** **Bike ride** for scouts that are 14 and older or First Class or younger with a parent. **Rifle range.** **Trail to First Class** Advancements. **Frisbee** and/or **football.** **Totin' Chip**♣ for younger scouts.

♣ **Totin' Chip** (bring Scout Handbook): This certification grants a Scout the right to carry and use woods tools. Scout leaders will work with the younger scouts that he understands his responsibility to do the following:

- Read and understand woods tools use and safety rules from the Boy Scout Handbook.
- Demonstrate proper handling, care, and use of the pocket knife, ax, and saw.
- Use knife, ax, and saw as tools, not playthings.
- Respect all safety rules to protect others.
- Respect property. Cut living and dead trees only with permission and good reason.
- Subscribe to the Outdoor Code.
- *The Scout's "Totin' Rights" can be taken from him if he fails in his responsibility.*

## SHOOTING PERMISSION & RELEASE

California State Law prohibits any person from furnishing, loaning or otherwise providing a minor any firearm or live ammunition without the express permission of their parent or guardian. Your son will not be allowed on the shooting range without the following signed release.

As required by California Penal Code Sections 12552, 12070, 12072 and 12078, et. seq. to the Boy Scouts of America, Camp Josepho, Western Los Angeles County Council, Verdugo Hills Council, Troop 125, and to leaders and instructors established by the Boy Scouts of America (National), to furnish a firearm, BB Gun, Air Rifle, Pellet Gun, or 002 Gun, and Ammunition to said minor for the purpose of instructing him in the safe handling of firearms, safe shooting and marksmanship.

I do further agree to indemnify and save harmless the Boy Scouts of America, Verdugo Hills & Western Los Angeles County Councils and all officers, members, employees, and volunteers thereof, from all suits or actions brought for, or on account of, any injuries or damages received or sustained by any person or persons by or from the consequences of any negligence or any act or omission of the above named minor occurring during the course of said instruction.
