Camp Chawanakee sits among towering pines on a peninsula that is fondly referred to as "The Point." The camp is located on the shores of Shaver Lake in the Sierra Nevadas East of Fresno.

The camp has evolved into a center for all Scouting activities including younger boy programs as well as older boy programs. The horse program was dropped in the 1960's but revived in 1991. C.O.P.E. was added in 1987 to challenge the older boys to new heights. The "Trail to First Class" was added in 1991 to help younger Scouts advance through the early ranks of Scouting. The Mountain Man program was added in 1991. The purpose of this program was to teach outdoor survival skills to Scouts. Kayaks made their appearance at our waterfront area in 1997.

The Mountain Bike program came in 1999. In 2000, a high adventure program called Leave No Trace made its debut for older Scouts. In 2002 we will be adding our new 52' climbing wall to the program. Camp Chawanakee's program now ranks as one of the most comprehensive in the nation.
